<u>Position Responsibilities and Requirements</u>

Worship:

- Deliver engaging sermons that are meaningful for the wide variety of religious backgrounds in our congregation.
 Sermons should not only draw upon the scripture lessons but interpret them in ways that apply broadly to the world we live in, and specifically to our daily lives.
- Lead communion service once a month.
- Lead special worship services, including Holy Week and Christmas Eve.

Pastoral Care:

• Collaborate with the Deacons to provide pastoral care through visitation, counseling, and prayer. Officiate at special services, such as weddings and funerals.

Administration:

- Serve as the church's spiritual and administrative leader.
- Supervise and work in close communication with the church secretary.
- Participate in regular meetings of the Trustees and Deacons to facilitate communication and maintain a working knowledge of the church budget.

Qualifications:

- A graduate degree from an accredited seminary or divinity school and experience in a ministry position is preferred but not required.
- Exceptional written and oral communication skills.
- An open mind and heart toward diversity of all types.
